



## Brainlab, Inc. (“Brainlab”) Annual Declaration of Compliance with California Law

The medical device industry has established various voluntary codes of ethics, such as the AdvaMed Code of Ethics on Interactions with Health Care Professionals ("AdvaMed Code").
